Prayer of Brokenness (based on the writings of St. Julian of Norwich)

Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, was led into the wilderness, where he was tempted.

- Sheltering God, Guiding God, as you were present with Jesus in his wilderness experience, so you are present with us: you have urged us to trust you: "Love me and call upon me, and I will answer you, I will be with you in trouble, and will honor you."
